

Course Regulations

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The SIR course consists of several meetings. There are:

- lectures,
- practical workshops.

The university Teams platform may be also used for distance meetings.

The project is performed individually by each-person.

- The project must be completed, and summarized in a report, at the end of the semester, i.e. 2023.01.27. The report should be submitted in a PDF file.
- The reports sent after the due date will not be evaluated.
- At the end of the semester, each project team will make a presentation of the results.

Final grade

- There are 7 practical distance learning exercises = 7 x 7 pts = 49 pts.
- There is a project = 21 pts.
- There is final exam at the end of the semester = 30 pts.

To obtain positive grade from the course you must obtain positive scores from all workshop exercises, from the project and exam. The positive score means more than half points, i.e. more than 24, 10 and 15 respectively.

The final grade is estimated, based on the sum of gathered points from exercises, project and exam:
